RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING FEBRUARY 15, 2026, AS NATIONAL SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER APPRECIATION DAY IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, the National Association of School Resource Officers (NASRO) established National School Resource Officer Appreciation Day in 2022 to encourage schools and communities to recognize the valuable work of School Resource Officers; and

WHEREAS, School Resource Officer programs across the globe are founded as collaborative efforts by police agencies, law enforcement officers, educators, students, parents, and communities to create safe learning environments, provide valuable resources to school staff members, foster positive relationships with students and develop strategies to resolve problems that affect youth with the goal of protecting all children, so they can reach their fullest potential; and

WHEREAS, School Resource Officers are valuable and essential members of the education community and deserve unwavering respect and support from the public in the pursuit of keeping schools and students safe.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes February 15, 2026, as School Resource Officer Appreciation Day in Solano County. The Board also commends the School Resource Officers for their dedication and distinguished service to the citizens and school-aged children of Solano County.
