

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-208

**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RATIFYING THE
CONTINUANCE OF THE LOCAL EMERGENCY DUE TO THE DECEMBER 2024 WINTER STORMS**

WHEREAS, Government Code section 8630 and Solano County Code sections 7-12 (a) and (b) and 7-13 (a)(1), authorize the Solano County Administrator, acting as the Director of Emergency Services, to proclaim a local emergency as defined by Government Code section 8558, subdivision (c) when the Board of Supervisors is not in session; and

WHEREAS, on December 21, 2024, the Assistant County Administrator, acting as the Director of Emergency Services, found that due to the December 2024 Winter Storms, which began on December 13, 2024, and King Tides, that conditions of extreme peril to life, property, and/or the environment existed in Solano County and proclaimed a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, at a special meeting on December 27, 2024, the Solano County Board of Supervisors confirmed and ratified the Proclamation of Local Emergency based on the conditions that continued to exist in Solano County under Government Code section 8630 and other applicable laws; and

WHEREAS, the Solano County Board of Supervisors voted to continue the Proclamation of Local Emergency at the February 11, 2025, April 22, 2025, June 10, 2025, and August 5, 2025 meetings; and

WHEREAS, the emergency conditions no longer warrant the continuation of the local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Solano County Board of Supervisors confirms the need to terminate the local emergency previously issued for the December 2024 Winter Storms.
