**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
RECOGNIZING MAY 7, 2025, AS THE
63rd ANNUAL COMMEMORATION OF PEACE OFFICERS' MEMORIAL DAY
AND RECOGNIZING MAY 11-17, 2025, AS
POLICE OFFICER APPRECIATION WEEK IN SOLANO COUNTY**

WHEREAS, in 1962, President John F. Kennedy designated May 15th as Peace Officers' Memorial Day, and the week in which it falls as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Solano County Sheriff's Office, and approximately 900,000 additional law enforcement officers across the country, play an essential role in promoting and safeguarding the rights and freedoms of American citizens; and

WHEREAS, the public know and understand the duties, responsibilities, hazards, challenges, and sacrifices law enforcement personnel face when performing their jobs on a daily basis; and

WHEREAS, of equal importance, law enforcement officers must recognize the risks of their sworn duty to serve their communities when safeguarding life and property, protecting against violence and disorder, and preventing deception and oppression; and

WHEREAS, through the constant application of new procedures and techniques, the Solano County Sheriff's Office has evolved into a modern and scientific law enforcement agency which efficiently and unceasingly provides a vital public service for our community; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the nation's 63rd annual Peace Officer Memorial Day, and in tribute to the fallen officers in the State of California and the nation who have made the ultimate sacrifice in service to the citizens they serve; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that we express our gratitude for the dedicated service and courageous deeds of law enforcement officers and for the contributions they have made to the security and well-being of all our people.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors recognizes May 7, 2025, as the 63rd Annual Peace Officer Memorial Day and the week of May 11-17, 2025, as Police Officer Appreciation Week and commends the Solano County Sheriff's law enforcement officers for their dedication and distinguished service to the citizens of Solano County, and with special recognition, the Solano County Board of Supervisors recognizes those peace officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty.
