**WHEREAS**, the benefits of preventing and overcoming substance use and /or mental health disorders are significant and valuable to individuals, families and the community at large; and


**WHEREAS**, prevention of substance use and/or mental disorders works, treatment is effective, and people in Solano County and throughout the nation do recover; and
