

**FOURTH ADDENDUM
TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING MOU 48-16992**

1. The title of this Addendum is Fourth Addendum to **Memorandum of Understanding MOU 48-016992** (“MOU”) between the **SUPERIOR COURT OF CALIFORNIA, COUNTY OF SOLANO** (“Court”), and the **SOLANO COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT** (“County”),
(collectively the “Parties”).

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a Memorandum of Understanding under MOU 48-016992 dated July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2024, in which the Court, in partnership with County, is responsible to meet requirements of the Pretrial Program;

WHEREAS, the parties amended the MOU on January 1, 2023, adding additional services to support the Pretrial Program and increase utilization of one-time fund and ongoing fund for FY2022-2023 and FY2023-2024, (“Addendum 1”);

WHEREAS, the parties amended the MOU on April 2, 2024, adding additional services to support the Pretrial Program and increase utilization of ongoing fund for FY2023-2024, (“Addendum 2”);

WHEREAS, the parties amended the MOU on June 24, 2024 to add additional services to support the Pretrial Program and increase utilization of ongoing fund for FY2023/2024 and to extend the time of performance to terminate on June 30, 2025, (“Addendum 3”);

WHEREAS, in 2025 the name of the state’s pretrial program was changed from “Pretrial Release Program” to “Pretrial Services Program”;

WHEREAS originating with the Senate Bill 129 amending the Budget Act of 2021, each budget bill provides funding to all courts for the implementation of statewide pretrial service programs;

WHEREAS, the total funding appropriation for the Court for Fiscal-Year 2025-2026 shall not exceed \$640,422.12. The Court may retain up to 30 percent of the total funding for costs associated with pretrial service programs and practices. Courts may contract with and provide the remainder of the funds to any county department for pretrial service activities, except those departments or agencies that have primary responsibility for making arrests or prosecuting criminal offenses.

2.0 This extension or modification becomes effective: **July 1, 2025**

3.0 The parties agree to amend the MOU as set forth below:


- A. The Court in collaboration with the County will continue to provide Pretrial Services Program to accomplish the key purpose of the Pretrial Services Program funding, as set forth by the legislation, which is to support:
- Judicial officers in making pretrial release decisions that impose the least restrictive conditions to address public safety and return to court; and
 - Implementation of appropriate monitoring practices and provisions of services for released individuals.
 - In the limited cases where electronic monitoring is ordered as a condition of pretrial services release, the judicial officer shall review the matter every 45 days to consider whether there are less restrictive conditions of release that would enhance public safety and ensure the individual's return to court. If less restrictive conditions of release are warranted, the judicial officer shall order removal of the electronic monitor or modify the terms of the electronic monitoring order to achieve the less restrictive alternative.
 - When electronic monitoring is ordered, a 45-day review hearing will be scheduled by the Court. Prior to the hearing, Probation will provide the Court with a review memo, which will include information for the judicial officer to determine whether electronic monitoring shall continue, stop or be modified.
 - Implementing a 45-day review process will support best practices, ensure SB129 restrictions are followed, and aid in lessening the high financial costs associated with the use of electronic monitoring.
 - If the actual cost associated with the use of electronic monitoring exceed the total amount of funding allocated for Fiscal-Year 2025-2026, the use of electronic monitoring is subject to review, and an amendment to this contract may be considered to ensure the availability of funds for pretrial services.
- B. The time of performance is amended to take effect beginning **July 1, 2025** and ending **June 30, 2028**.
- C. The total amount that the Court may pay the County from the approved allocation to the Court for Fiscal-Year 2025-2026, under the MOU, by this Fourth Addendum, is **\$448,295**. This amount may be spent or encumbered by **June 30, 2026** ("FY25-26 fund").
- D. The budget detail for the total amount of \$448,295 as outlined in **Exhibit D-4** attached hereto is incorporated herein and made a part of this Fourth Addendum.
- E. The Court and County can begin to record qualified program expenditures

made on or after July 1, 2025, and retroactively bill these expenses to pretrial services funding.

- F. Funding appropriated for the pretrial program is contingent on the annual budget bill and subject to change. Funding beyond the current appropriation year is conditional upon appropriation by the Legislature of the State of California of sufficient funds to support pretrial services. Should such an appropriation be approved, the Court may notify the County in writing of the forthcoming annual allocation amount once the budget bill is enacted.

4.0 Except as provided in this Addendum, all other terms and conditions specified in the MOU remain in full force and effect. This Fourth Addendum to the MOU shall be effective upon the signature of those persons or officials authorized to act on behalf of their respective agencies. It shall retroactively be in force from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2028.
