**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING THE
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH UNIT 18 – LAW ENFORCEMENT
MANAGEMENT**

Whereas, Solano County Law Enforcement Management Association represents the employees in Bargaining Unit 18 – Sheriff's Office Management within the County; and

Whereas, the County and the Association are required under the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act to meet and confer in good faith regarding wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment; and

Whereas, the County of Solano and the Association, having met and conferred in good faith reached a total tentative agreement on successor collective bargaining agreement for Unit 18 – Sheriff's Office Management; and

Whereas, the successor collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the membership of the Association and the Board of Supervisors is required to ratify the successor collective bargaining agreement.

Resolved, the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby enact the following:

1. Approve the Memorandum of Understanding with Solano County Law Enforcement Management Association for Unit 18 – Sheriff's Office Management; and
2. Authorize the Director of Human Resources to make any technical corrections.
