## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER 2025 AS FOOD SAFETY EDUCATION MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, the Solano County Board of Supervisors considers the health and well-being of its residents and visitors its highest priority; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation has designated September 2025 as National Food Safety Education Month to emphasize the importance of food safety education within the foodservice industry; and

**WHEREAS**, many public and private organizations and regulatory agencies are coordinating activities during the month of September 2025 to raise awareness of approved food sources and labeling of products purchased in the community and distributed in the workplace; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Resource Management performs food safety inspections at the 2,002 food facilities permitted in Solano County, which includes educating operators on proper food handling practices, storage, labelling, and using approved food sources; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout September 2025, the Department of Resource Management will be coordinating with other Bay Area and Central Valley environmental health agencies and the United States Food and Drug Administration to educate retail food facility operators and the public on the importance of proper food sourcing and preventing illness from unapproved sources; and

**WHEREAS**, on behalf of the residents and visitors of Solano County, we are pleased to join with local, State and federal agencies to ensure safe food handling practices and to promote public health throughout Solano County.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors declare September 2025 as Food Safety Education Month.
