**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
APPROVING TRAFFIC ORDER 422 ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE
FROM 10 P.M. to 6 A.M. ON ROCKVILLE ROAD**

WHEREAS, Chapter 17 of the Solano County Code sets forth the requirements for the establishment of traffic orders; and

WHEREAS, Engineering and Traffic Surveys have been made on Rockville Road; and

WHEREAS, based on said surveys and conforming to accepted principles and practices of traffic engineering, the Director of Transportation has made Traffic Order 422, establishing a no parking zone from 10 P.M. to 6 A.M. for commercial trucks and vehicles parking overnight on Rockville Road; and

WHEREAS, said traffic order does not become effective until it has been adopted by resolution by the Board of Supervisors.

RESOLVED, Traffic Order 422 is adopted prohibiting commercial vehicles and trucks parking between 10 P.M. to 6 A.M on both sides of Rockville Road from Green Valley Road to 500 feet east, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 17 of the Solano County Code.

RESOLVED, the Director of Transportation is directed to place "No Parking" signs on Rockville Road between Green Valley Road and 500 feet east of Green Valley Road.
