**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING
THE GRANT OF A NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT AND APPROVING A RIGHT OF
ENTRY AGREEMENT TO SOLANO IRRIGATION DISTRICT AT 2543 CORDELIA
ROAD IN FAIRFIELD (APN 0044-250-080) FOR THE INSTALLATION AND
MAINTENANCE OF A WATER PIPELINE ACROSS COUNTY PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, Solano County owns certain real property at 2543 Cordelia Road in Fairfield, Assessor's Parcel Number 0044-250-080 ("the Property"); and

WHEREAS, Solano County, the Solano Irrigation District, the Solano Transportation Authority and Caltrans have coordinated on infrastructure planning related to the Westbound Interstate-80 Cordelia Truck Scales Project and its potential effect on Solano Irrigation District facilities; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 20-foot-wide non-exclusive easement encompasses approximately 0.799 acres, and the proposed 60-foot-wide Right of Entry area lies adjacent to the easement; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 25526.6 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to grant and accept easement interests when the conveyance and Right of Entry Agreement are in the public interest and do not conflict with County use of property; and

WHEREAS, the easement and agreement are in the best interests of the Solano County and the general public.

RESOLVED, the Solano County Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Administrator to execute a Grant of Easement and Right of Entry Agreement with the Solano Irrigation District for the installation and maintenance of a water pipeline across a portion of the Property for the sum of \$6,900, and to take all other necessary actions as required.
