RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HONORING CRAIG PYLE, ENGINEERING SERVICES SUPERVISOR, UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCE MANAGEMENT
