RE: Continued from March 26, 2013; Receive a report on, and consider whether to direct staff to initiate a process for preparing a proposed amendment to the Solano County Code, Chapter 2, regarding the composition of the Airport Land Use Commission's membership, and direct the County Administrator to initiate the process

Bill Emlen, Director of the Department of Resource Management, noted that this matter was in response to an earlier discussion by the Board and a request to discuss options for modifying the criteria for appointments made to the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC).

Jim Leland, Department of Resource Management, provided the Board with a summary of the evolution of the ALUC and the parameters that affect how the ALUC can operate within the County government system. Mr. Leland noted that the ALUC was functioning well, was a highly technical committee, and current efforts were underway to update Land Use Compatibility Plans required for the three airports operating in the County which included Travis Air Force Base, Rio Vista Airport, and Nut Tree Airport. Mr. Leland noted that the Plans were in suspension at this time due to the State freezing the grant money previously promised to the cities and County.

At the conclusion of discussion, no action was taken by the Board and the composition of the Airport Land Use Commission's membership remained unchanged.
