RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES RECYCLING AND RECOVERY FOR ALL GRANTS, PAYMENT PROGRAMS AND RELATED AUTHORIZATIONS FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code, §40000 et seq. the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) is authorized to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California's efforts to reduce, recycle and reuse solid waste generated in the State thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code, §48000 et seq., CalRecycle has established various payment programs to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of these authorities CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding and management of the grants and administration of the payment programs; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering grant applications and payment programs require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants and payment programs; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code, §42023.1 subdivision (g), CalRecycle is authorized to make payments to local governing bodies within a recycling market zone for services related to the promotion of the zone.

RESOLVED, the Solano County Board of Supervisors, for regional grant applications, authorizes the Director of Resource Management to submit applications to CalRecycle for any and all grants and payment programs for which the County of Solano is eligible.

RESOLVED, the Solano County Board of Supervisors, for regional grant applications, authorizes the Director of Resource Management to submit a letter of authorization as a regional participant to a designated Lead Agency or submit a regional application(s) as the Lead Agency on behalf of itself and the cities of Benicia, Dixon, Fairfield, Rio Vista, Suisun City, Vacaville and/or Vallejo.

RESOLVED, the Director of Resource Management is authorized and empowered as Signature Authority to execute in the name of the County of Solano all documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, third-party contracts, term extensions and requests for payment necessary to secure CalRecycle grant and payment program funds and implement the approved grant and payment program project(s).

RESOLVED, these authorizations are effective for five (5) years beginning February 10, 2026.
