

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO STANDARD CONTRACT  
BETWEEN COUNTY OF SOLANO AND THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA**

This First Amendment is made on March 3, 2021, between the COUNTY OF SOLANO, a political subdivision of the State of California ("User") and THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA ("University") on behalf of its Davis campus UC Davis Continuing and Professional Education.

1. Recitals

- A. The parties entered into a contract dated November 16, 2020 (the "Contract"), in which University agreed to provide staff development and training.
- B. The User now needs to amend the Contract ("First Amendment") to increase the contract amount and number of training units.
- C. This First Amendment represents an increase of \$15,810 and additional 4 units of training.
- D. The parties agree to amend the Contract as set forth below.

2. Agreement

A. Scope of Work

Section 1 of Exhibit A is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

21.5 Unit(s) of training in the subject areas selected by the agency from the UC Davis Continuing and Professional Education curriculum.

B. Amount of Contract

Section 3 of Exhibit A is deleted in its entirety and replaced with:

User will provide the following:

- a. Training facility and audio-visual equipment.
- b. On-site coordination of training.
