NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

(Planning Commission)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Solano County Planning Commission will hold a PUBLIC HEARING to consider an ordinance, zone text amendment ZT-26-02, which would amend Section 28.72.10(B)(2) of the Solano County Zoning Code to rescind and replace regulations of accessory dwelling units and junior accessory dwelling units; the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080.17 [this amendment serves to implement state ADU and JADU regulations] and CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) [there is no possibility the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment]. The hearing will be held on **Thursday, May 7, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.** in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, County Administration Center, 1st Floor, 675 Texas Street, Fairfield, California.
