2023-2024 K-12 student enrollment

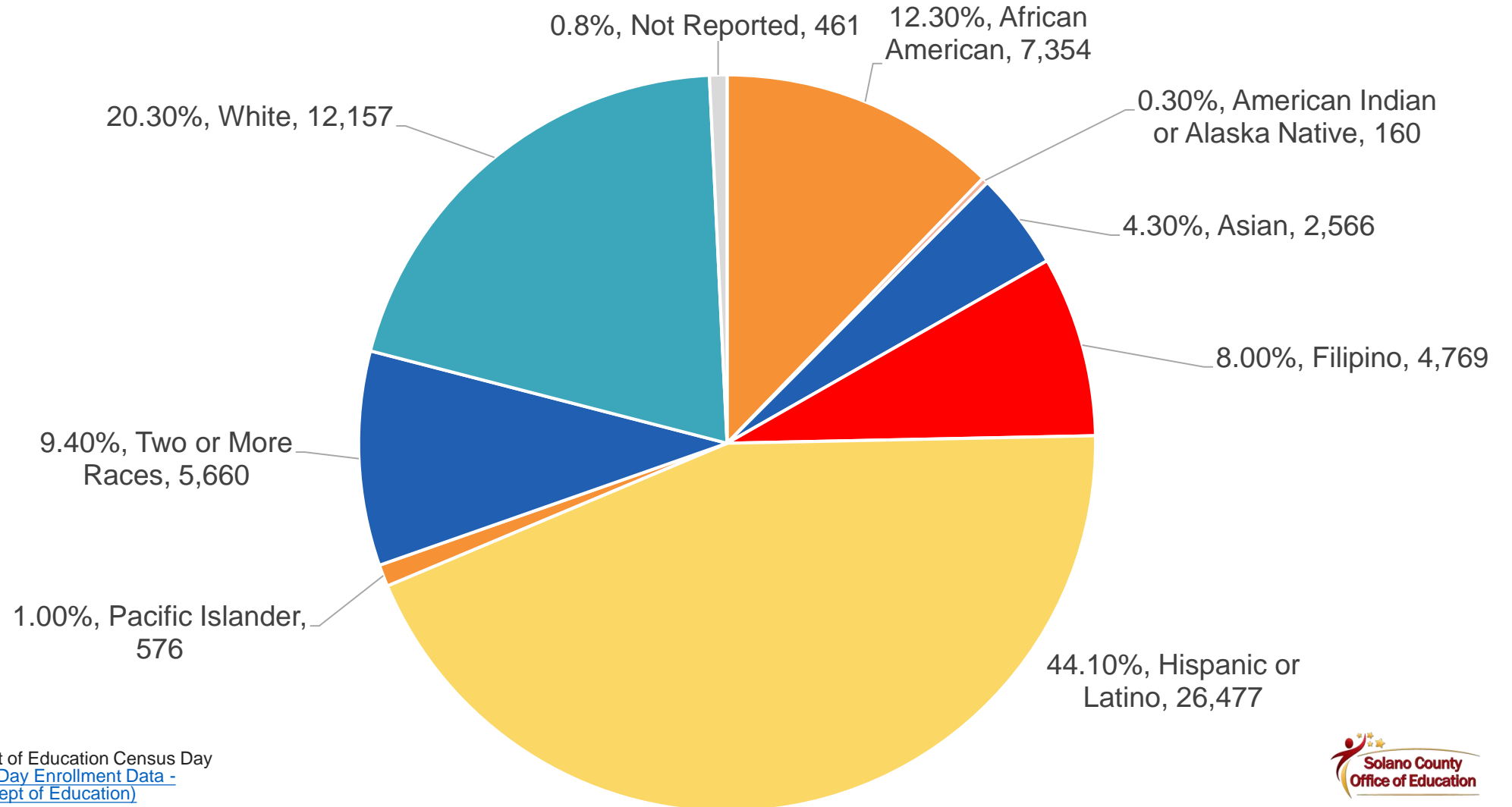

Williams relevant legislation: School visitation selection

Schools eligible for comprehensive support and improvement (CSI)

OR

Schools eligible for additional targeted support and improvement (ATSI)

OR

Schools where 15 percent or more of the teachers are holders of a permit or certificate, such as a temporary or short-term permit, a substitute permit, a waiver, an intern credential, or any other authorization that is a lesser certification than a preliminary or clear California teaching credential

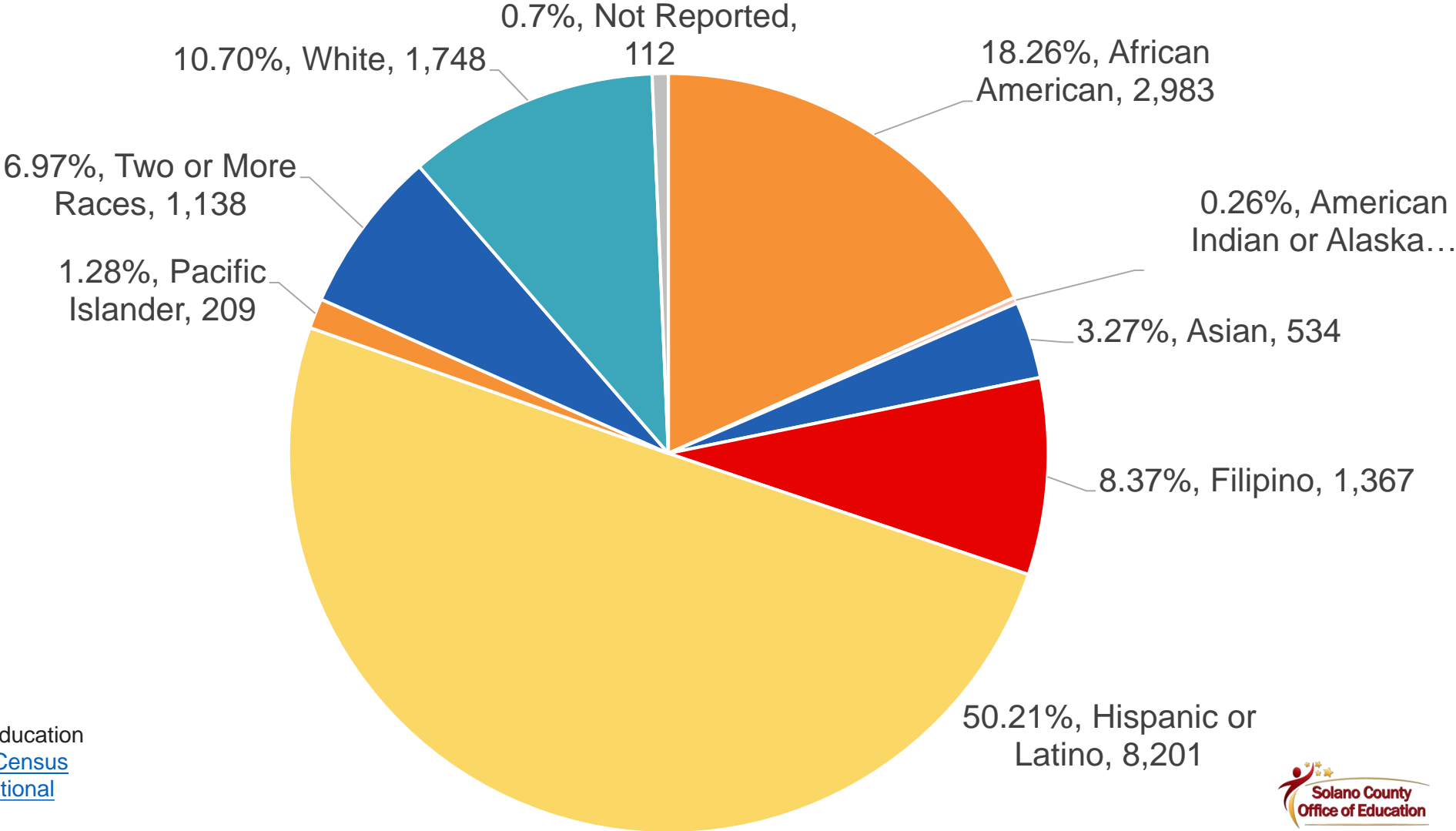
“Commencing with the 2021–22 fiscal year, ... The list established in the 2021–22 fiscal year shall also be used as the list established in the 2022–23 and 2023–24 fiscal years. The list of schools established pursuant to this section shall be reestablished in the 2024–25 fiscal year and again every three fiscal years thereafter. Each list shall be established in accordance with clause (ii), and shall be used for inspections beginning the following fiscal year.”
