**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE SOLANO COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY, OR DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION AND RELATED DOCUMENTS TO THE CALIFORNIA GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE UNSERVED/UNDERSERVED VICTIM ADVOCACY AND OUTREACH PROGRAM**

**Whereas** the County of Solano desires to continue an Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program to be supported with Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Victim Assistance Formula Grant Program funds authorized by the Victims of Crime Act of 1984 as amended, 42 U.S.C. 10601, et seq.; and

**Whereas**, the Solano County District Attorney seeks to submit a grant request for award to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) in the amount of \$196,906 for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026.

**Resolved**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Solano County District Attorney, or designee, to submit a grant application and related documents to the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program in the amount of \$196,906 for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2026.
