RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF MAY 13, 2025, AS JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS (JROTC) WEEK AND RECOGNIZING THE CADETS OF THE FAIRFIELD HIGH SCHOOL CA-032 AIR FORCE JROTC PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Air Force Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) program at Fairfield High School, known as the CA-32nd Cadet Corps with 117 cadets, is a valuable leadership development and training program that tremendously benefits these young student cadets and Solano County; and

WHEREAS, in School Year 2024-2025, the cadets contributed more than 2,407 community service hours to the Solano County, FSUSD School District, and to Fairfield High School; and, accomplished 1,487 hours of JROTC Leadership Development Requirement training, in preparing the Color Guard / Sabre Team, Drill Teams, and the Corps for performances in the community; all while maintaining strong academic focus and actively participating in JROTC and extracurricular activities; and

WHEREAS, the cadets supported numerous community and school-sponsored activities, to include: the Fairfield Coast and Creek Cleanup, Rotary Club Pumpkin Patch Festival, Fairfield Adopt-A-Street Program; and multiple school-wide sporting events, festivals, and ceremonies; and

WHEREAS, cadets showed their esprit de corps and teamwork – the hallmark of the military tradition - by participating in the 2024 Fairfield Veterans Day Parade; performed Color Guard services during numerous community civic ceremonial functions, FSUSD academic and student-focused events; and the Cadet Corps further hosted retired U. S. military service veterans on the school campus for commemoration ceremonies, which include: September 11 Commemoration Day, Veterans Day, Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, and Memorial Day; and


WHEREAS, Fairfield High School cadets voluntarily joined the Junior ROTC program, which provides varied instructional education in Aerospace Science and Leadership; and further provides cadet leadership opportunities with strong emphasis on personal responsibility, developing positive character traits, incorporating discipline, and supporting the school and community through service. Many of these cadets have assumed key leadership positions and responsibilities within the AFJROTC Program, within the school, and in the community; thus, providing valuable and useful experiences in their individual growth and development as positive servant leaders and residents; and

WHEREAS, the cadets at Fairfield High School, under the guidance and leadership of their dedicated instructors, Major Frank Aguon, Jr. (Senior AFJROTC Instructor) and Master Sergeant Javier Martin-Vinas, are diligently working toward acquiring the experience, knowledge, and training necessary to become successful and productive citizens in our society.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors proclaims the week of May 13, 2025, as Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) Week in Solano County and recognizes the outstanding JROTC program at Fairfield High School and the noteworthy accomplishments of the cadets and instructors of the CA-32nd Cadet Corps.
