# Objective:

The objective of the County Coordinator Grant Project is to educate, encourage, and develop county-wide collaboration and coordination among the county's various wildfire mitigation groups.

Counties and their coordinators will work closely with the California Fire Safe Council to: (I) Build a census of all active wildfire mitigation groups in their county, (II) Analyze gaps in county-wide wildfire resiliency and emergency preparedness and develop recommendations to fill these needs, (III) Develop mechanisms to improve outreach and coordination efforts.

On August 3<sup>rd</sup> and August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024, we participated in a residential Green Waste Recycling Event at five (5) locations throughout the County. Future events are being planned in conjunction with the Solano Fire Safe Council (SFSC).



In May of 2024 Solano County participated in the annual Wildfire Community Preparedness Day. Preparations have begun for this National Event taking place in 2025. We are looking to hold this event in South County, tentatively in either Vallejo or Benicia.



In late November of 2024, Solano County hired an Emergency Services Coordinator to focus primarily on wildfire and coordinate with the three fire safe councils.
