RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING TRAFFIC ORDER 423 ESTABLISHING A 7-TON WEIGHT LIMIT ON MANKAS CORNER ROAD

WHEREAS, Chapter 17 of the Solano County Code sets forth the requirements for the establishment of traffic orders; and

WHEREAS, Engineering and Traffic Surveys have been made on Mankas Corner Road; and

WHEREAS, based on said surveys and conforming to accepted principles and practices of traffic engineering, the Director of Public Works Engineering has made Traffic Order 423, establishing a 7-ton weight limit for through-going commercial trucks on Mankas Corner Road with agricultural trucks exempted; and

WHEREAS, said traffic order does not become effective until it has been adopted by resolution by the Board of Supervisors.

RESOLVED, Traffic Order 423 is adopted prohibiting through-going commercial trucks exceeding a gross weight of 7 tons on Mankas Corner Road, from Suisun Valley Road to the Fairfield City Limits at Waterman Boulevard, with agricultural trucks exempted, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 17 of the Solano County Code.

RESOLVED, the Director of Transportation is directed to place 7-Ton weight limit signs on Mankas Corner Road.
