

# *Resolution No. 2026-*

## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PROCLAIMING JANUARY 2026 AS POSITIVE PARENTING AWARENESS MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, raising children and youth to become healthy, confident, capable individuals is the most important job parents and caregivers have; and

**WHEREAS**, positive parenting is a protective factor that strengthens family relationships, increases parents' confidence, and drives children's social, emotional, and relational health and development; and

**WHEREAS**, the quality of caregiving, beginning prenatally, is one of the most powerful predictors of children's future social, emotional, physical, and behavioral health, and the well-being of those raising children is essential to the well-being of our community; and,

**WHEREAS**, in Solano County, families can receive support from various positive parenting programs, including Triple P-Positive Parenting Program, an evidence-based program which offers parents and caregivers a "tool kit" of proven strategies to strengthen families and develop positive relationships by teaching simple strategies any parent can adopt to suit their own values, beliefs and needs; and

**WHEREAS**, multiple agencies throughout Solano County provide Triple P Positive Parenting services, including Bay Area Community Resources, Child Start Inc., Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District - Healthy Start Family Resource Center, and Main Street Youth and Family Services (formerly Parents by Choice); and

**WHEREAS**, research confirms that positive parenting creates positive childhood experiences (PCEs), and children who experience safe, stable, and nurturing relationships develop empathy, self-regulation, communication skills, and problem-solving capacity that protect against interpersonal, family, and community violence; and

**WHEREAS**, Triple P is an effective and universal parenting intervention, serving approximately 10,314 parents of diverse backgrounds in Solano County over the last eight years; and

**WHEREAS**, during the month of January, the First 5 Solano Children and Families Commission along with four Triple P providers will increase awareness of the importance of positive parenting and the availability of resources such as Triple P.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Solano County Board of Supervisors does hereby proclaim January 2026 as Positive Parenting Awareness Month in Solano County.
