## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2026 AS NATIONAL HUMAN TRAFFICKING PREVENTION MONTH IN SOLANO COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, National Human Trafficking Prevention Month was established in January 2010 to bring to light that human trafficking is an illegal trade; and

**WHEREAS**, human trafficking is a growing problem in the United States and around the world; and

**WHEREAS**, California, with its large immigrant communities, the world's fifth-largest economy, and extensive international border, is considered one of the top four states in the United States for human trafficking; and

**WHEREAS**, human trafficking primarily involves exploitation, which comes in many forms, including forcing victims into prostitution, subjecting victims to slavery or involuntary servitude, and compelling victims to commit sex acts for the purpose of creating pornography; and

**WHEREAS**, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) estimates one out of seven children reported missing to NCMEC was likely a child sex trafficking victim; and

**WHEREAS**, National Human Trafficking Prevention Month is an opportunity to recognize the critical role we all play in preventing, reporting, and adjudicating these heinous crimes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Solano County Anti-Human Trafficking Coalition and the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC) Steering Committee are collaborative teams of the Health and Social Services Department's Child Welfare Services and Behavioral Health divisions, law enforcement, the District Attorney's Office, the Solano County Office of Education, and a host of community-based organizations, are committed to increasing awareness.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby designates the month of January 2026 as National Human Trafficking Prevention Month in Solano County and encourages all residents of Solano County to learn more about the issue of human trafficking.
