# Contract Conditions



Approval of the contract by Vallejo by July 1, 2025.



Written confirmation from the California Department of Justice (DOJ) that the Sheriff will not be subject to the existing settlement agreement between the DOJ, Vallejo, and the Vallejo Police Department (VPD).

**PENDING**

The County must complete meet and confer process with Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Law Enforcement Management Association (LEMA), and the Deputy Sheriffs' Association (DSA), regarding the proposed contract.

Approval of the contract by the Board of Supervisors by June 30, 2025 – date extended to July 22, 2025.



# Updates Since June 24<sup>th</sup> BOS Meeting

- ✓ HR worked with CalPERS to clarify the limitations on the use of retired annuitants. As a result of updated guidance from CalPERS, staff believes that the County can meet the contract's staffing requirements.
- ✓ Staff worked through purchasing and contracting; believes the necessary equipment, technology, and fleet procurement can be completed on schedule.
- ✓ Meet-and-confer with SEIU.
- ✓ Meet-and-confer with LEMA.
- PENDING** Meet-and-confer with DSA.



# Sheriff Request

The Sheriff recommends that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Receive an update on the Sheriff Office's ability to provide temporary law enforcement assistance to the City of Vallejo;
2. Provide direction on a proposed contract for services; and
3. If applicable, consider delegating authority to the County Administrator, with County Counsel and General Services concurrence, to approve any necessary exemptions to the County Contracting and Purchasing Policy in order to expedite related purchases.
