RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING THE WEEK OF MAY 20-26, 2018 AS EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES (EMS) WEEK IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services (EMS) is a vital public service; and

WHEREAS, access to quality medical care dramatically improves the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden illness or injury; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 theme, "EMS STRONG: Stronger Together," recognizes an emergency medical services system that is comprised of highly committed physicians, nurses, emergency medical technicians, paramedics, firefighters, educators, administrators, air ambulances and others; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Medical Services teams provide lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

WHEREAS, the members of emergency medical services teams, whether career or volunteer, engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and




