## RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HONORING URLITA CORONEL-MANGUNE UPON HER RETIREMENT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES WITH 23 YEARS OF DEDICATED PUBLIC SERVICE TO SOLANO COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, Urlita Coronel-Mangune began her more than 23-year career in public service on March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2001, working for the County of Solano as Architectural Projects Coordinator; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Coronel-Mangune was promoted to the position of Capital Projects Coordinator-Senior on February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016, commensurate with the responsibility and experience earned for leading and delivering highly complex capital projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Coronel-Mangune worked diligently with Architectural Services/Capital Projects Management Division to support and lead delivery of County projects totaling hundreds of millions of dollars in completed capital projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Coronel-Mangune supported and/or led the delivery of major capital projects including the County Administration Center (CAC), Juvenile Detention Facility (JDF), Stanton Correctional Facility, Rourk Vocational Training Center, and the current County Energy Conservation project, among others, involving over \$150 million in State and public financing; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Coronel-Mangune supported delivery of the Solano County Juvenile Justice Detention Facility, with a project Certificate Merit conferred by the American Institute of Architects Academy of Architecture for Justice, and with selection for publication in the *2007 Justice Facilities Review*; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Coronel-Mangune coordinated the production of the County's annual 5-Year Capital Facilities Improvement Plan (CFIP) for over twenty years, helping ensure the timely completeness of information presented; and

**WHEREAS**, Ms. Coronel-Mangune has served as both mentor and invaluable resource to her colleagues in the Capital Projects Management Division of General Services Department sharing her experience in the multiple aspects of project coordination and contract management, enjoying the respect and admiration of her colleagues.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes Urlita Coronel-Mangune for 23 years of faithful and dedicated service and wishes her well in her retirement and future endeavors.
