

**ORDINANCE NO. 2016- 1777**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20 OF THE SOLANO COUNTY  
CODE, RELATING TO HUMAN RESOURCES**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Solano ordains as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 20-11 is amended to read:

**Sec. 20-11 Civil service commission**

(a) The board of supervisors shall create a civil service commission, establish its membership, qualifications, an appointment and removal process, and compensation of *its* members, all in accordance with the provisions of Sections 2-700 through 2-703.

(b) Each year the commission *members shall elect a president and vice-president.*

(c) Three members shall constitute a quorum, and it shall take three affirmative votes to make any action effective.

(d) The commission shall meet at least once a month and at other times as needed at the call of the president.

**Section 2. Effective Date**

This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its passage.

**Section 3. Publication**




