RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING SEPTEMBER 2024 AS NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH IN SOLANO COUNTY

WHEREAS, National Preparedness Month is a nationwide effort held each September; and

WHEREAS, National Preparedness Month promotes public awareness about the importance of being prepared for a full range of emergencies and encourages communities to take action to strengthen the security and resiliency of our families, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Solano County Office of Emergency Services is to protect lives, property, and the environment by preparing for, responding to, recovering from, and mitigating the effects of natural and human caused emergencies, the Office of Emergency Services continues to raise public awareness; and

WHEREAS, the communities of Solano County should join cities, special districts, nonprofits, and community-based organizations across the nation to ensure action is taken, including accessing disaster preparedness information readily available on the County's website and to get involved with emergency preparedness and planning.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the communities of Solano County, hereby recognizes the month of September 2024 as "National Preparedness Month."
