## **RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING MARCH 1-7, 2026, AS WEIGHTS AND MEASURES WEEK IN SOLANO COUNTY**

**WHEREAS**, March 1-7, 2026, is recognized as Weights and Measures Week throughout the United States, commemorating signing of the nation's first weights and measures law in 1799 by President John Adams; and

**WHEREAS**, weights and measures laws establish standards for commercial weighing and measuring devices including product labeling and quantity requirements for packaged goods and quality, advertising, and labeling requirements for petroleum products; and

**WHEREAS**, the uniform and transparent enforcement of weights and measures laws support services and sales of goods accounting for nearly half the annual gross domestic product of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the County's Weights and Measures program resides within the Agriculture Department and serves to provide consumer protection, and transparent and fair competition in the local commercial marketplace; and

**WHEREAS**, County Weights and Measures Inspectors inspect and test over 7,000 commercial weighing and measuring devices including retail motor fuel dispensers; electric, gas and water meters; propane meters; and grocery, vehicle and livestock scales at 630 business locations annually.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes March 1-7, 2026, as Weights and Measures Week in Solano County.
