Solano Child Care Planning Council Membership Application

<u>Mission</u>: The mission of the Solano County Child Care Planning Council is to provide leadership and advocacy for the development of high quality, accessible, and affordable child care programs for every child and family in Solano County.

<u>Purpose</u>: The purpose of the Child Care Planning Council is to assess and prioritize Solano County child care and development needs and develop and implement, as appropriate, plans to address those needs. The Child Care Planning Council is committed to the belief that all children in Solano County will have equal access to community services and support and experience high quality, safe, healthy, and nurturing care, and education. The Child Care Planning Council shall collaborate with public and private partners to maximize child development resources.

The California Department of Education assigns the Child Care Planning Council various responsibilities and provides funding through an annual contract to support this work. The Child Care Planning Council members are appointed by the Solano County Board of Supervisors and/or the County Superintendent of Schools. The Council is responsible to the Board of Supervisors and Superintendent of Schools in carrying out its assigned tasks.

<u>Membership Expectations</u>: The term of office is for two years from the date of appointment. Meetings are convened a minimum of six times per year; usually every other month from 1:00– 2:00 pm, with one or two meetings held in the evenings. Council members are expected to attend all regular meetings

Membership Categories:

Each of the 5 categories represented on the Local Planning Council has 3 positions:

Parents/Child Care Consumers: parents or persons who receive or who have received child care services within the past 36 months.

Child Care Providers: persons who provide child care services or represent persons who provide child care services.

Public Agency Representatives: persons who represent a city, a county, or a local education agency.

Community Representatives: persons who represent an agency or business that provides private funding for child care services or who **advocate** for child care services through participation in civic or community-based organizations but are not child care providers and do not represent agencies that contract with the California Department of Education to provide child care and development services.

Public/Discretionary Member: persons from any of the above categories or outside of these categories at the discretion of appointing agencies.

I have had the opportunity to partner with Child Start/Head Start and have had the privilege to serve on the California Mentor Program selection committee and the Early Childhood Education (ECE) Advisory Committee. I have also had opportunities to collaborate with public and private partners to maximize child development resources for the Early Learning Center (ELC) at the Community College. These partnerships helped me build stronger ties in the community, allowing me to provide leadership and advocacy for developing high-quality programs in Solano County.
