RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING AUGUST 26, 2025, AS NATIONAL WOMEN'S EQUALITY DAY

WHEREAS, National Women's Equality Day marks the adoption of the 19th Amendment in 1920, which granted women the right to vote; and

WHEREAS, women of the United States have been treated as second-class citizens and have not been entitled the full rights and privileges, public or private, legal or institutional, which are available to male citizens of the United States; and

WHEREAS, women in the United States have continuously worked to gain full rights and privileges – public or private, legal or institutional – as citizens of the United States; and

WHEREAS, women in every state and every cultural and religious group worked to secure women's right to vote; and

WHEREAS, Congress has designated August 26th, the date the Nineteenth Amendment was certified, as Women's Equality Day; and

WHEREAS, recognizing National Women's Equality Day as a day of celebration throughout the country emphasizes the importance of women's work for democracy and demonstrates the importance of the women's suffrage movement and the work to secure and expand equal rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby recognizes August 26, 2025 as National Women's Equality Day, as a national day celebrating the importance of the women's suffrage movement and the work to secure and expand equal rights.
