

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-1830

ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21-10 OF CHAPTER 21 OF THE SOLANO COUNTY CODE RELATING TO DISTURBING THE PEACE DUE TO LOUD OR UNUSUAL NOISE DURING THE HOURS OF 10:00 P.M. AND 6:00 A.M.

The Solano County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 21-10 of Chapter 21 of the Solano County Code is amended as follows:

Sec. 21-10. Disturbing the Peace

No person shall maliciously and willfully disturb the peace and quiet of any neighborhood or person by loud or unusual noise or by tumultuous or offensive conduct or threatening, traducing, quarreling, challenging to fight or by fights. For purposes of this section, loud or unusual noise includes any non-agricultural noise any time after 10:00 p.m. or before 6:00 a.m. that exceeds 65 dBA at the property line.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall take effect 30 days after its adoption.

Section 3.

A summary of this ordinance will be published within 15 days after its adoption in the Fairfield Daily Republic, a newspaper of general circulation in Solano County.
