SPECIFICATIONS OF THE ELECTION ORDER FOR A  
SPECIAL BOARD MEMBER ELECTION IN THE  
TRAVIS UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Travis Unified School District (TUSD) governing board member Dawn Kirby filed her resignation with the Solano County Superintendent of Schools on May 21, 2014.

WHEREAS, Ms. Kirby's resignation created a vacancy on the TUSD governing board in Trustee Area 1.

WHEREAS, the TUSD governing board did not make a provisional appointment or order an election to fill the vacancy within 60 days of the vacancy as required by Education Code section 5091(a).

WHEREAS, Education Code section 5091(a) requires that, in the event a governing board fails to make a provisional appointment or order an election within the prescribed 60-day period, the county superintendent of schools must order an election to fill the vacancy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that:

1. Pursuant to Education Code sections 5091(a) and 5302(a), a special governing board member election is ordered for March 3, 2015, for the purpose of electing a person to fill the Trustee Area 1 vacancy; and

2. The individual elected to fill the vacancy will hold office for the remainder of the term in which the vacancy occurred with a term expiration of December 7, 2018. (Education Code §5000 and §5091(e))
