PROJECT BACKGROUND

February 2013

 Board of Supervisors authorized application for State SB1022 grant funding to construct facilities to provide rehabilitation programs and services for local adult offenders to reduce recidivism.

March 2014

 State notified County of conditional award of \$23,037,000 to construct the proposed rehabilitation facilities.

October 2016

Board of Supervisors authorized "best value" procurement for the vocational training center project.

January 2017

 Board of Supervisors authorized the Department of General Services to solicit best value bid proposals from four pre-qualified contractors and approved a Project Labor Agreement for the project.




Construction of two new buildings totaling 39,340 square feet on 3.8 acres of Countyowned land located at the Clay Bank Campus in Fairfield:


Classroom and Administration Building – 9,940 square feet

BEST VALUE PROCUREMENT PROCESS

- October 2016 the General Services Department solicited Statements of Qualifications from contractors interested in bidding the project.
- Six SOQs were received/evaluated. Four contractors deemed qualified and invited to submit bid proposals
- All four contractors submitted best value bid proposals.
- Hensel Phelps Construction Company was determined to be the best value contractor for the stipulated sum of \$18.5 million, including all project enhancements requested by the County.
