## RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR AN UNSERVED/UNDERSERVED VICTIM ADVOCACY AND OUTREACH PROGRAM

Whereas, the County of Solano desires to establish an Unserved/Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program to be supported with Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Victim Assistance Formula Grant Program funds authorized by the Victims of Crime Act of 1984 as amended, 42 U.S.C. 10601, et seq.; and

Whereas, the Solano County District Attorney submitted an application to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and is authorized to accept the grant award in the amount of \$350,000 for the period of April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2018, and to execute the CalOES grant agreement and any subsequent amendments.

**Resolved**, neither the Board nor the District Attorney may use the grant funds to supplant expenditures controlled by either of them.

**Resolved**, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and CalOES disclaims responsibility for such liability.
