RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER 2017 AS NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH IN SOLANO COUNTY

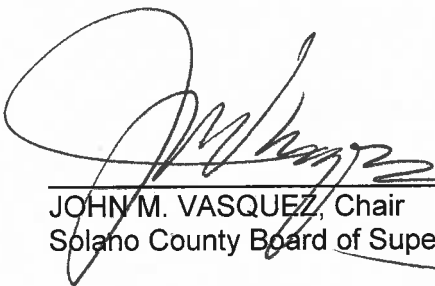

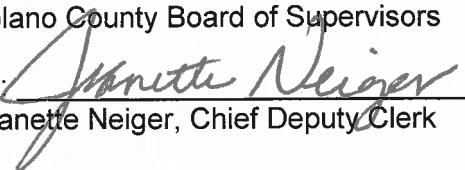
