## RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING PARTICIPATION IN THE 2017 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF, UNDERSHERIFF, DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES AND/OR EMERGENCY SERVICES MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY ACTIONS NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE 2017 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT

Whereas, the State of California's Office of Emergency Services, annually allocates federal funds administered through the State's Homeland Security Grant Program for the purpose of improving prevention and protection capabilities at the state, local, tribal and territorial levels to prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events and to prepare for threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of the United States; and

Whereas, the Sheriff's Office has prepared the 2017 Homeland Security Grant Expenditure Plan and intends to submit an application for funding to the State of California's Office of Emergency Services.

Resolved, the Solano County Board of Supervisors approves Solano County's participation in the 2017 Homeland Security Grant Program for the period September 1, 2017 through May 31, 2020, and authorizes the Solano County Sheriff, Undersheriff, Director of Administrative Services and/or Emergency Services Manager to apply for, accept, administer and sign operational contracts, modifications and reimbursements for the purpose of obtaining federal financial assistance through the 2017 Homeland Security Grant provided by the Federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-awarded through the State of California.
