## RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING NOVEMBER AS IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES HOME CARE WORKERS MONTH IN SOLANO COUNTY

**WHEREAS**, numerous organizations have joined together in declaring the month of November as In-Home Supportive Services Home Care Workers Month to recognize, honor and support the valuable contributions of home care workers; and

**WHEREAS**, the California In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) program is recognized nationally and has been replicated in other states as a preferred way to provide assistance to people who need long-term care; and

**WHEREAS**, providing services and support for the disabled and elderly to remain living in their homes is a humane, dignified, and compassionate alternative to hospitalization or other institutional placement; and

**WHEREAS**, more than 4,100 IHSS home care workers provide home care services and support which makes it possible for approximately 4,770 low-income disabled and elderly residents in Solano County to remain living independently in their homes; and


**WHEREAS**, the work of Solano County's IHSS home care workers requires sensitivity, honesty, patience, trust, commitment, dedication, and compassion; and
