Solano360 Specific Plan Project Update – County Fairgrounds Site

- Obsolete Building/Site Demolition Project Plan
 - Demolish Horse Barns, Grandstands and possibly Expo Hall County General Fund/Deferred Maintenance
 - Bid Solicitation in March 2018
 - BOS Contract Award in June 2018
 - Demolition starts in July 2018 with completion by October 2018
 - Relocation of Existing AT&T Cell tower on Grandstands to be relocated onsite – discussions in process

October 2017 – Mutual Aid Emergency Animal Shelter Operations at Fairgrounds

- Over 550 Animals Housed
- Over 1,000 Working Volunteers
- 14-day period
- Board of Supervisors authorized up to \$100,000 advance against Emergency Relief Fund for State and FEMA reimbursement
- Seeking Authorization for up to additional \$27,000 to cover mutual aid costs at Fairgrounds









History of Solano County and Fair Association

- Solano County Fairs from 1946-2018
 - Delivered by the Solano County Fair Association (SCFA)
 - SCFA established by resolution in 1946
 - Current Management Agreement in 2011 with a series of Amendments over recent years
 - Current Management Agreement expiration 2020
- Loss of Local Horse Racing 2010
- State Elimination of Subsidies to all Fairs
- Fair Association Struggles as an Enterprise Fund
 - Reserves Diminished
 - No significant funds for Capital Renewal or Maintenance
 - No funds for long-term Pension Costs


