RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMENDING THE PERSONNEL AND SALARY RESOLUTION

Whereas, the Personnel and Salary Resolution establishes benefits, working conditions and related terms and conditions of employment for employees not covered under a collective bargaining agreement or who are exempt from the County's civil service regulation; and

Whereas, the Personnel and Salary Resolution requires modification from time to time.

Resolved, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors authorize the Director of Human Resources to make any technical corrections if needed; and

Further resolved, that the Solano County Board of Supervisors amends the Personnel and Salary Resolution and the following sections or subsections as follows:

Section 14, Holidays, paragraph I, Holidays, subpart 2, Other Paid Holidays, shall read:

- a. One (1) paid floating holiday in each calendar year. The timing of an employee's use of the floating holiday shall be subject to advance approval of the Department Head or his/her designee.
- b. Effective January 1, 2019, and for regular and limited term confidential employees who have retained their Civil Service status, one (1) paid holiday in each calendar year. The timing of an employee's use of the floating holiday shall be subject to advance approval of the Department Head or his/her designee.
- c. Special or limited holidays appointed by the President or Governor.
- d. Such other days in lieu of holidays as the Board of Supervisors may determine.
