- On May 2, 2017 Measure K renewed 15 years
  - Passed by Super Majority 66.7%

#### Projected to bring \$2.3 Million a year

- Assist with keeping Parks and Facilities clean and open
- Assist with ongoing programing for Children, Adults, and Seniors
- Updates and repairs to aging facilities
- Replace and Update Playgrounds
