RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE
SOLANO PROBATION PEACE OFFICER ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Solano Probation Peace Officer Association (SPPOA) is the recognized representative for job classifications designated as Units 12 and 15, within the County; and

WHEREAS, the County and the SPPOA are required under the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act to meet and confer in good faith regarding wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment; and

WHEREAS, the County of Solano and SPPOA, having met and conferred in good faith reached a total tentative agreement on a successor collective bargaining agreement for Units 12 and 15; and

WHEREAS, the successor collective bargaining agreement has been ratified by the membership of the SPPOA and the Board of Supervisors is required to ratify the successor collective bargaining agreements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Solano County Board of Supervisors hereby enact the following:

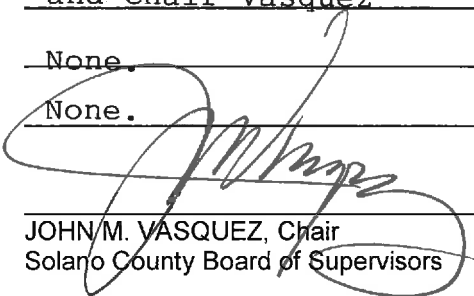
1. Approve the Memoranda of Understanding with the Solano Probation Peace Officer Association for Units 12 and 15.

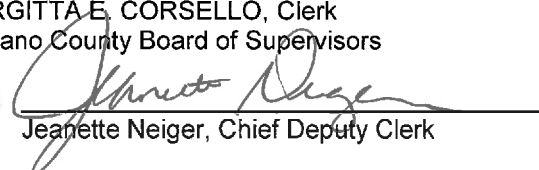
