**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DIRECTING
PREPARATION OF ANNUAL ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR THE GREEN VALLEY
OPEN SPACE MAINTENANCE DISTRICT**

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Solano (the "County"), State of California did, on October 2, 1990, by its Resolution No. 90-260, order the formation of and levied the first assessment within the County of Solano, Green Valley Open Space Maintenance District (the "District"), pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 (commencing at Section 22500 of the California Streets and Highways Code) (hereinafter "the Act"); and

Whereas, Sections 22620, et seq., of the Act provide for the levy of annual assessments after formation of the District; and

Whereas, within the District, the existing and proposed improvements and any substantial changes proposed to be made to the existing improvements are generally as described on Exhibit "A" attached and by this reference made a part of this resolution.

Resolved, that the Director of the Resource Management Department of the County of Solano is designated as Engineer of Work for purposes of the District and is hereby ordered to prepare and file an annual report for FY2018/2019 in accordance with Section 22565, et seq., of the Act.

EXHIBIT "A"

DESCRIPTION OF IMPROVEMENTS

The work shall include the acquisition and maintenance of open space land in the Green Valley area. Green Valley is that area bounded by Suisun Valley Road on the east, Interstate 80 and State Highway 12 on the south, and a line in the ridgetops to the north and west, which line is to be defined pursuant to the planning process initiated by City of Fairfield Resolution 89-89.
