Whereas, the Department of Health Care Services, Substance Abuse Disorder Compliance Division, Driving Under the Influence (DUI) Unit, licenses and performs compliance monitoring on all DUI programs in California; and

Whereas, the objectives of the DUI program are to reduce the number of repeat DUI offenses by persons who complete a state-licensed DUI program and to provide participants an opportunity to address problems related to the use of alcohol and/or other drugs; and

Whereas, Health and Social Services currently contracts with Healthy Partnerships, Inc., a California for-profit corporation, to administer Solano County Substance Use Disorder Programs, including the DUI Program; and

Whereas, on April 18, 2018, notice was provided by Caminar, Inc. that it intends to purchase assets of Healthy Partnerships and will assume obligations of certain Healthy Partnerships various executory contracts; and

Whereas, Caminar, Inc. has the capability and agrees to comply with all DUI Program service requirements.

Resolved, the Solano County Board of Supervisors approves Caminar, Inc. as a new DUI provider in Fairfield and Vacaville.
