**RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
HONORING CUSTODY SERGEANT MICHAEL HARRISON
UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE SOLANO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE
WITH OVER 28 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO SOLANO COUNTY**

WHEREAS, Michael Harrison began his service with Solano County's Sheriff's Office as a Correctional Officer – Entry Level on June 26, 1990 and promoted to Journey Level Correctional Officer on July 7, 1991. He worked nearly every assignment at all Sheriff's facilities, including Roving Officer and Tunnel Holding Officer; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Harrison is noted as being one of the first officers in the Custody Classification Unit and he was a member of the Gang Intelligence Unit; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Harrison was promoted to Sergeant-Corrections on May 14, 2000, and reclassified, with the addition of limited peace officer powers per §30.1(c) of the California Penal Code, to Custody Sergeant on July 31, 2012, where he held an assignment in supervising booking; and


