Receive a verbal update on Delta Water issues, including the proposed 28 19-178 California WaterFix and EcoRestore Programs, as well as the status of known planned ecosystem restoration projects; Consider providing direction to staff on moving forward with the development of the General Plan policy and zoning standards concepts described in the report and attachments that could be applied to the Cache Slough area; and Provide direction on the merits of adopting an interim urgency ordinance intended to slow or prevent ecosystem restoration projects in Cache Slough that would convert agricultural land until а management plan more comprehensive or standards/policies are in place

On motion of Supervisor Spering, seconded by Supervisor Thomson, the Board directed staff to move forward with the development of specific Cache Slough General Plan policies and zoning standard concepts described in the report and attachments addressing proposed ag conversion ecosystem restoration projects in the Cache Slough region, to include both General Plan policies and zoning standards specifically addressing the Cache Slough area with the intent of providing greater clarity as to how such projects might be considered and the type of mitigation that would be required.
