RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RECOGNIZING MAY 2019 AS MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH

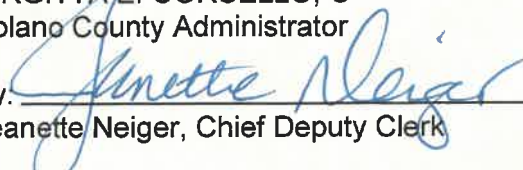
WHEREAS, each business, school, government agency, healthcare provider, organization and citizen share the responsibility to promote mental wellness and support prevention efforts across the community.
