Second Amendment

The parties recognize that the current Agreement is for a term of May 1, 2011 through April 30, 2019, unless otherwise mutually extended by the parties in writing (Section 4, Term and Separation, paragraph A). The parties mutually agree to extend the Agreement to expire on April 30, 2022, unless otherwise mutually extended by the parties in writing.

Except as set forth in this Second Amendment, all other terms and conditions specified in the Employment Agreement remain in full force and effect.


