RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF 2+/- ACRES OF RIGHT OF WAY EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC ROADWAY AND PUBLIC UTILITY PURPOSES FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR GRIZZLY ISLAND ROAD
