RESOLUTION OF THE SOLANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE SOLANO COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR A VICTIM WITNESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Whereas, the County of Solano desires to continue a Victim Witness Assistance Program to be supported with Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Victim Assistance Formula Grant Program funds authorized by the Victims of Crime Act of 1984 as amended, 42 U.S.C. 10601, et seq.; and

Whereas, the Solano County District Attorney submitted a grant request for award to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and is authorized to accept the grant award in the amount of \$776,470 for the period of October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020, and to execute the CalOES grant agreement and any subsequent amendments.

Resolved, that any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant Award Agreement, including civil actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and CalOES disclaim responsibility for such liability.
