

program delivery; assess opportunities for policy changes aimed at reducing chronic disease within the community; assist with organizing two conferences; and provide technical assistance and training about health equity issues and community engagement. H&SS's Solano Public Health worked with HIP last year to perform similar work.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board may choose not to approve the contract. This is not recommended because it would prevent H&SS's Solano Public Health from expanding media outreach to promote the prevention and early intervention of chronic diseases.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

H&SS worked with the County Administrator's Office and County Counsel to develop the contract.
