

On December 8, 2015, the Solano County Board of Supervisors passed and adopted resolution that established the amount of the facilities impact fees for Dixon Public Library District which became effective on February 8, 2016.

In order to comply with the Mitigation Fee Act, Government Code section 66006(b) requires a review and disclosure of impact fee funds annually. The Dixon Public Library District provided this information at its noticed Governing Board of Library Trustees meeting on November 22, 2019 where the information was also available to the public.

In compliance with Government Code section 66006(b)(2), a notice of the time and place of this meeting, including the address where this information may be reviewed, is mailed at least 15-days prior to today's Board meeting to all interested parties who have filed a written request with the Clerk of the Board. Notification was sent to all parties on file and a notice was published in the legal section of the Daily Republic.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could choose not to accept the Dixon Public Library District disclosures. This action is not recommended as the disclosures are required by the Mitigation Fee Act to provide information to the public concerning collections and expenditures of library impact fees. As long as the County collects these fees on behalf of the Dixon Public Library District, this disclosure will be required.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The Dixon Public Library District received and approved the attached disclosure report at their November 22, 2019 District Board meeting.
